Admissions Information

ALL students are required to submit the following information to the MCC Admissions Office (2000 College Drive, Madisonville, Kentucky, 42431) in order to be fully admitted. Please see below for additional requirements.

- Application for Admission (including the Entering Student Survey listed on back of the application)
- Skills Assessment Test (ACT, Asset, or Compass)
- High School Transcript or GED scores
- Official transcript(s) from any other college(s) attended

New Students: All **new** students (applicants who have never attended another college or university as a degree-seeking student) are required to attend a First Semester Experience orientation and advising session prior to registration. Additional information is provided following the submission of the application for admission. Students may also visit www.madisonville.kctcs.edu/fse for information.

Transfer & Visiting Students must submit official transcripts from all other colleges attended in addition to the requirements listed above. Please note: you must request that our Registrar's Office evaluate your transcript credit, once received by MCC Admissions, in order to transfer any coursework to MCC. In addition, visiting students must submit a completed Transient Student Form or a letter of good standing from their home college.

High School Students, taking classes prior to their graduation, must submit their high school transcript and the completed Early Admission Form in addition to the requirements listed above. Other testing and grade point average requirements apply. Students may also visit www.madisonville.kctcs.edu/admissions for information.

Admission Deadlines: Students are required to submit all required information to the Admissions Office on or before specific deadlines. Please consult the MCC course schedule for admission application and other deadlines. Consult program coordinators for specific program admission deadlines.

Placement Information

Placement exams are required of all incoming degree-seeking freshmen and like all public higher education institutions in Kentucky, MCC observes a mandatory placement policy. Test scores must be less than 5 years old and are required to be submitted prior to student registration.

All students are required to take the Compass test unless ACT scores exempt them. You may be exempt from COMPASS if you have ACT scores of 18 or above in English, math, and/or reading or have successfully completed college-level English and math courses. An 18 composite on the ACT does not exempt you from all sections of the COMPASS. Students who do not meet minimum scores on any or all the ACT sections of English (minimum score of 18), reading (18), and/or math (18) will be required to take the Compass test for appropriate course placement. Students who do not submit test scores will be considered non-degree seeking and, as a result, will not be eligible for financial aid.

The MCC Assessment Center administers the Compass test by appointment only. Interested students should contact the Assessment Center (824-1702) in order to make an appointment to take the Compass or for more information. The Asset is given in Muhlenberg County. Contact the CAP (Career & Academic Planning) Center for more information (824-8621). You may register for the ACT online at www.actstudent.org.

You cannot fail the placement test. However, students are strongly encouraged to do their best when taking an exam. Selective admission programs may require COMPASS or other test scores for program admission.
