

Radiography Selection Process

Admission to Madisonville Community College does not guarantee admission to the Radiography Program. The guidelines outlined below establish requirements for selection into the Radiography Program.

Selection of applicants for the program will be made by the President of the college or the President's designee after considering the recommendation of the admissions committee. Membership of this committee shall be as follows:

- ❖ Radiography Program Director
- ❖ Radiography Clinical Coordinator
- ❖ Allied Health Division Chair
- ❖ Admissions Officer or Dean of Student Affairs
- ❖ Counselor

Each applicant must submit the following credentials by March 1st in order to be considered by the admission committee.

- ❖ Application for admission to the college.
- ❖ Official high school transcript indicating that the applicant has completed an approved 4-year high school curriculum or the GED certificate.
- ❖ Transcripts of all postsecondary education or training.
- ❖ ACT or COMPASS score reports.
- ❖ A statement verifying at least a four-hour observation/work experience in a Radiology Department must be completed and returned to the college. (Official college observation form must be used).
- ❖ Submit a letter to program director before March 1st.

An interview or pre-admission conference may be required prior to admission to the Radiography program.

Test scores requirement for program admission:

Preference scores:	ACT Composite:	19	
	COMPASS	Writing	75

		Algebra	41

Preference may be given to:

1. Applicants with an ACT Composite of 19 or above; or COMPASS scores in Algebra – 41 or above, in Reading – 81 or above, and in Writing – 75 or above.
2. Applicants who have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better (4 point scale) in prescribed prerequisites applicable to the Radiography program.
3. Applicants who have completed the biological and physical sciences and mathematics courses listed in the Radiography curriculum with a grade of “C” or better.

Those applicants who have met preference 1, 2, and 3 will be selected for the next class based on date of application.
