CRC Chair, Sarah Oglesby, asked for a volunteer to serve as Recorder to replace Dawn Chumley. Debbie Cox volunteered to serve and was appointed by the Chair.

Course proposals from other colleges were examined.

HUM 150 Introduction to African Literature	No problems noted with this proposal
ENG 282 International Film Studies	The Humanities Division noted an issue with the language in the course outline. This feedback will be given to the system CRC
IMT 251 Maintaining Industrial Equipment Lab II	No problems noted with this proposal

Program proposal for Integrated Nursing Program was examined.

- This discussion represented the 2nd time CRC has discussed the program. A Nursing curriculum from Hawaii was shared with the committee. It was noted that their approach was to eliminate ENG from the curriculum.
- Dr. Janssen questioned the career pathway and transferability of the proposed program.
- Linda Thomas explained that competencies are sequenced throughout the program from PN to ADN and addressed the question of transfer, clarifying the pathway approach.
- Dr. Janssen brought to the attention of the committee the introduction of MT 150 and that there is no math requirement in the PN pathway with the exception of dosage calculations.
- Dawn Chumley asked whether the competencies from 137, 139, and 225 were deleted from the curriculum. Elaine Terry noted all competencies were examined and included in either a science course or a nursing course.

- Sarah Oglesby noted a problem will be encountered in getting Cycle C material approved in time for inclusion in the following year's catalog. She asked Debbie Cox to bring this to the attention of the Deans and KCTCS administration. It would be advisable to move printing of the catalog as late in spring as possible to accommodate this cycle.
- Sarah Oglesby informed the group she will support the Integrated Nursing Program Proposal when presented to the System CRC.
